<u>USE DIRECTIONS:</u> First, turn engine off then lightly wet down surfaces to be cleaned by spraying in short bursts from a distance of 18 to 24 inches. **Do not spray on hot metal surfaces like exhaust pipes.** After the surfaces have been wetted, continue spraying at a distance of 12 to 18 inches to flush contaminants from surfaces. Spray brake parts thoroughly, then allow to air dry or wipe with soft clean cloth. If deposits are heavy, repeat application.
